



Statutory Responsibilities of DSAB include;

- Conduct S44 Safeguarding Adults Reviews
- Publish a Strategic Plan
- Publish an Annual Report outlining what Board members have done to contribute to the Strategic Plan

DSAB function is to:

- Co-ordinate what is done by each person or body represented on the Board for the purposes of safeguarding and promoting the welfare of adults in the area of the authority; and
- Ensure the effectiveness of what is done by each such person or body for that purpose; and
- Develop policies and procedures to safeguard adults at risk
- Develop training strategies to identify and respond to abuse

- Task and finish groups as and when required

7. Map responses to low level concerns across all partnership agencies and across the wider partnerships
Lead – Review and Learning
8. Raising awareness that abuse will not be tolerated and ‘Safeguarding is everyone’s business’

9. Prepare the Board for emergency ‘bombshell’ issues through a test workshop exercise
Lead – Prepare Group

What we will do:

10. Further refine the DSAB Performance framework to inform and assure the Board.

11. Hold agencies to account through appropriate challenge and monitoring of safeguarding practice.

12. To align the DSAB with other Boards, reducing duplication in the system, increasing efficiency and providing opportunities to re-invest.
