



# Active Autumn Family Fun Day

## Location

Sprotbrough Lock is beautiful spot on the Sheffield & South Yorkshire Navigations, around 3 ½ miles from Doncaster Town Centre. Next to 17th Century pub The Boat Inn, it is within an area of Outstanding Natural Beauty.

There is very limited parking on site but it is easily accessible by a range of transport models if you are travelling locally or from further afield.

## Arriving on foot

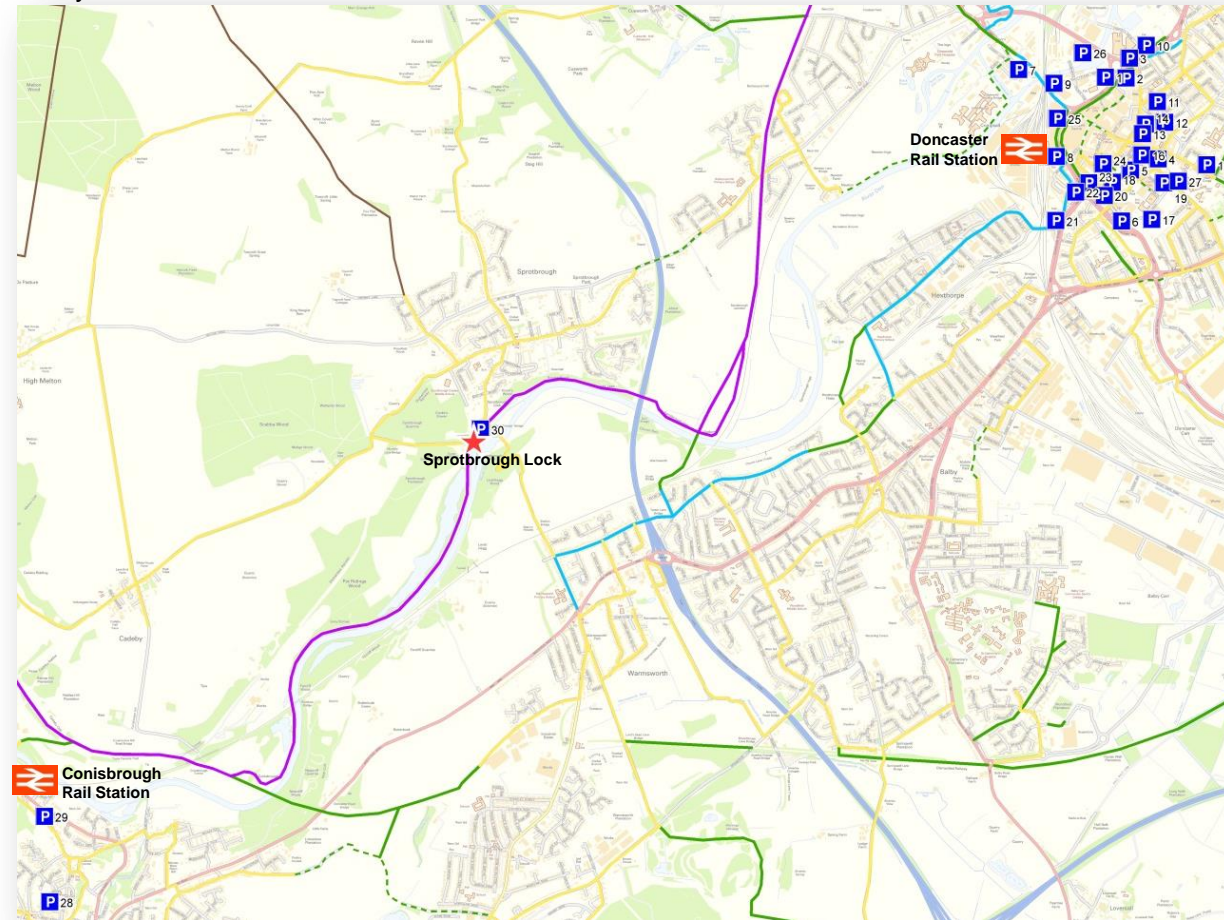
If you live locally, walking is by far the healthiest and cheapest way to get there. There is plenty of information available online to help you plan your route, simply set Sprotbrough Lock as your destination.

## Cycling to Sprotbrough Lock

Sprotbrough Lock is ideally located on Doncaster’s cycle network. The Trans Pennine Trail run directly past the site, providing off-road access to a range of destinations including the Town Centre and to Conisborough. The local network can be seen on the map opposite.

## Arriving by Bus

The closest bus stop to Sprotbrough Lock is Main Street/Boat Lane, a little over 10 mins walk away. The 219/219a services stop at Main Street/Boat Lane, running from Barnsley to Doncaster. 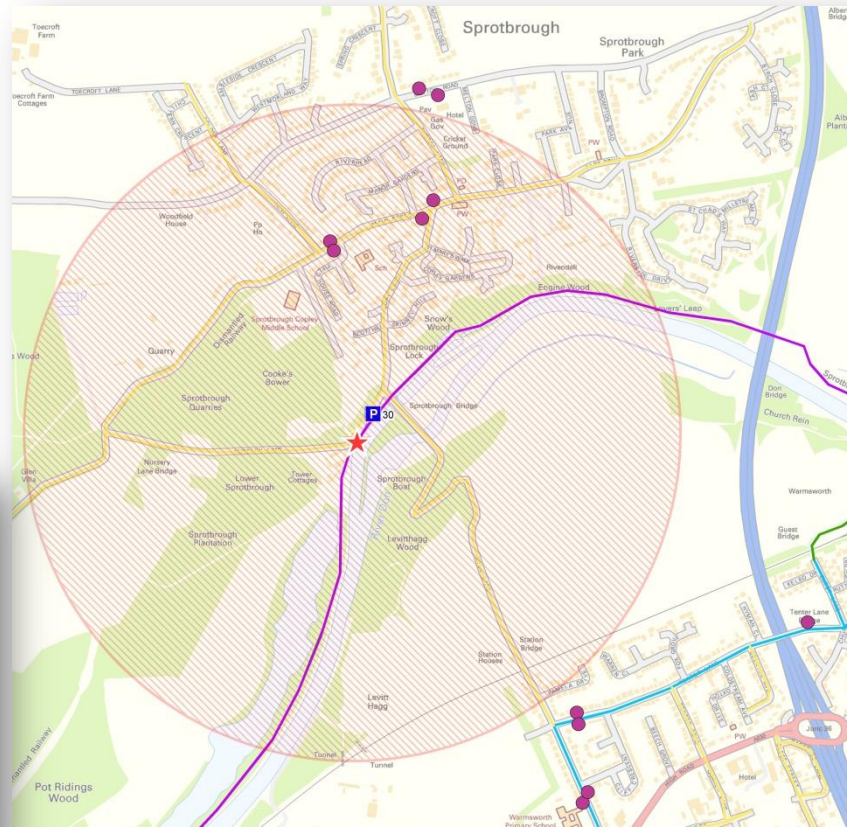
## Arriving by train

Doncaster Train Station is around 3 ½ miles from Sprotbrough Lock. The station is located next to the Doncaster Bus Interchange, where buses serving Sprotbrough depart every 30 minutes at peak time on a Saturday.

Conisbrough Train Station is a little over 4 miles away, and is served with buses to Doncaster Town Centre and to nearby Warmsworth. There is also easy access to the Trans Pennine Trail, so why not bring your bike and cycle from Conisbrough Train Station to Sprotbrough Lock.
