

## ARMTHORPE PARISH COUNCIL

### ARMTHORPE NEIGHBOURHOOD DEVELOPMENT PLAN

Following the public meeting held on 28<sup>th</sup> November 2012, the public engagement day on 1<sup>st</sup> December 2012, consultation with the public via the local library and with developers and landowners, Armthorpe Parish Council has now approved a provisional (pre statutory Regulation) Draft Neighbourhood Development Plan.

This provisional Draft Plan, which contains proposals for new housing sites, employment sites, transport and highways, the village centre, leisure and community facilities, etc., may be viewed for a period of three weeks from 5<sup>th</sup> August 2013 at the following:-

- 1 Armthorpe Community Centre, Church Street, Armthorpe, DN3 3AG, between 9 am - 1 pm and 6 pm - 8.30 pm Monday to Fridays
- 2 Armthorpe Public Library, Church Street, Armthorpe, DN3 3AL, during normal opening hours

The Parish Council will then consider and take account of all the comments and representations received, proceed to make a plan proposal and undertake a pre-submission consultation for six weeks in accordance with the statutory Regulations. It will also hold a public meeting during that period to inform residents and enable them to make further comments or representations.

Residents should be aware that if Armthorpe fails to agree a Development Plan, decisions on all the matters referred to above will be decided by developers, landowners, the local planning authority and the government.
